1. **Rules:** The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the *Racing Rules of Sailing*
2. **Eligibility:** Open Competition. NOT restricted to village residents, Class membership is NOT required.
3. **Fees:** none

5. **Boats:** there will be three divisions
  - a. Division I (Auxiliary Keel) Handicap under 200
  - b. Division II (Auxiliary Keel) Handicap 200 and over
  - c. Division III (cruising boat) open for boats that do not normally race
6. **Schedule of Events:** Saturday , September 17, 2011

7. **Measurements:** Measurement is not required, but yachts shall meet class measurements, and have a valid current SBCC handicap rating on file with the RC Chairman prior to the close of registration
8. **Sailing Instructions:** Available at registration
9. **Time Limit:** 4 hours

10. **Scoring:**

- a. Boats not carrying a legible sail number (minimum 6: high, dark colors, not back to back) on both sides of the sail will not be scored
- b. The "Time on Time" scoring method will be used**
- c. The current South Bay Cruising Club's handicaps will be used for base handicap data.

11. **Radio Communication:**

- a. The RC Signal Boat may communicate with competitors using VHF Channel 72.
- b. Failure of a competitor to have VHF, or to hear transmissions shall not be grounds for redress.

12. **Prizes:** Prizes will be awarded to the first three finishers (on correct time) in each division following the regatta
