

# NOTICE OF RACE

## THE LONG ISLAND YACHT CLUB WILL HOST AND SPONSOR VILLAGE OF BABYLON MAYOR'S CUP RACE

SUNDAY, SEPTEMBER 16<sup>TH</sup>, 2007

1. **RULES:** The regatta will be governed by *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
2. **RULES CHANGES:** Class membership is **NOT** required
3. **ELIGIBILITY:** Open Competition. **NOT** restricted to village Residents.
4. **FEES:** None.
5. **REGISTRATION:** At the Long Island Yacht Club clubhouse.
6. **BOATS:** Three Divisions  
Division I (Auxiliary Keel) Handicap under 200,  
Division II (Auxiliary Keel) Handicap 200 and over, and  
Division III Cruising Boat - Open for boats that do not normally race.
7. **SCHEDULE OF EVENTS:** Sunday, September 16<sup>th</sup>  
0930-1030 Registration  
1300 Warning Signal (Yellow)  
1305 Preparatory (Blue)  
1310 Division I (Red)  
1315 Division II (Yellow)

8. **MEASUREMENTS:** Measurement is not required, but yachts shall meet Class measurements, and have a valid, current SBCC handicap rating on file with the RC Chairman, prior to the close of registration. 9. **SAILING INSTRUCTIONS:** Will be available at Registration.
10. **COURSE(S):**
  - 10.1 Start will be established by Committee Boat off Willetts Creek to Flashing Green "9" off Oak Island Channel, leaving it to port; through the center span of Robert Moses Causeway Bridge to flashing Green "11", leaving it to starboard; to flashing Green "3" off Bayberry Point, leaving it to port; to flashing Green "1" off Bay Shore, leaving it to port; return through center span of the causeway bridge to finish line south of the Babylon Village Pool.
  - 10.2 Special course changes as defined in the Sailing Instructions may be signalled from the Committee Boat.
11. **TIME LIMIT:** 4 hours
12. **SCORING:** Handicap rating procedures as defined in the 2007 GSBYRA Yearbook will apply.
13. **RADIO COMMUNICATION:** The RC Signal Boat intends to communicate with competitors as necessary using VHF Channel 72. Failure of a competitor to have VHF, or to hear transmissions shall not be grounds for redress.
14. **PRIZES:** Prizes will be awarded to the first three finishers (on corrected time) in each division following the regatta.
