

LIYC 2007 JUNIOR SAILING PROGRAM REGISTRATION FOR JUNIORS AGED 8 – 18

For the 2007 LIYC JUNIOR SAILING PROGRAM Beginner Training will be given in OPTIMIST DINGHIES. Intermediate Training will be given in OPTIMIST DINGHIES, SUNFISH and CLUB 420s. Each Class section will be restricted to SIX students per class, except the CLUB 420 which will be restricted to 2 students per CLUB 420. We again will have two instructors, enabling us to run concurrent class sections. Every Friday is reserved for RACING. Students will race at LIYC & other Yacht Clubs. All Students are encouraged to attend on Fridays.

Any student is eligible to sign up for any or all courses at their skill level or a lesser skill level, **BUT**, LIYC reserves the right to limit students' courses in order to accommodate more students. There will be an Awards Party in August after all courses are completed. There will also be Skill competitions with Trophies.

I would like to apply for the following courses for my student. I understand that Sail Instruction courses are in LIYC owned Sailboats, though my student may utilize his OWN Sailboat. I agree to reimburse Long Island Yacht Club for the costs of any damage to Long Island Yacht Club property resulting from the negligent or irresponsible behavior of my student.

And I understand and agree....

1. all students must take and pass a swimming test in the LIYC pool and at the LIYC beach.
2. all students must wear an approved life jacket (with a whistle attached to the life jacket and have the student's name in LARGE BLOCK LETTERS on the back) at all times when on the water.
3. every student should come prepared to enjoy themselves, with an eager, attentive, respective & compliant attitude. Each student is expected to be polite, respectful and cooperative. It is fundamentally critical that the student be mentally prepared to obey the instructors' directions immediately & enthusiastically. LIYC intends the course will be conducted in a safe manner, but as the students will be operating out on the water, they may be subject to 'force majeure', they must be prepared to execute instructions in good faith relying upon the Instructors' experience & judgement
4. there shall be **NO Fighting, Disrespect, Obscenity, Theft, Rough Housing, Shenanigans, Hooliganism or Tom Foolery**; for infractions the Instructor may, in his discretion, remove the offender(s) from the day's instruction, remove the offender(s) from the course until the Member speaks with either the Junior Sailing Coordinator or the Commodore, remove the offender(s) from the course until the Member meets with either the Junior Sailing Coordinator or the Commodore OR expels the offender(s) from the course.
5. all students must take appropriate precautions, before class, to protect their skin from sun burn.
6. all students must wear boating shoes, sneakers or reef runners (**No Sandals!**), wear a bathing suit, have a ditty bag with a towel, sweat shirt (preferably red, orange, yellow or white, with a hood & long sleeves) and (at least one) bottle of water. It is also suggested that in the ditty bag are sunblock, insect repellent, sunglasses, hat, clean dry socks, sweat or athletic pants and a snack.
7. to pay LIYC (in the manner which the member normally pays the LIYC bills) \$400 * for the 1st course, plus _____ (the amount for additional courses).
8. to fill out and attach with this application **Exhibit B** – LIYC Waiver, Release and Indemnity Agreement, **Exhibit C** – LIYC Medical/Emergency Treatment Information, **Exhibit D** – LIYC Medical Release Form and **Exhibit E** – LIYC Children Drop Off & Pick Up Protocol And Emergency Notification List. Failure to do so will prohibit child from participation until Documents are signed and received.
