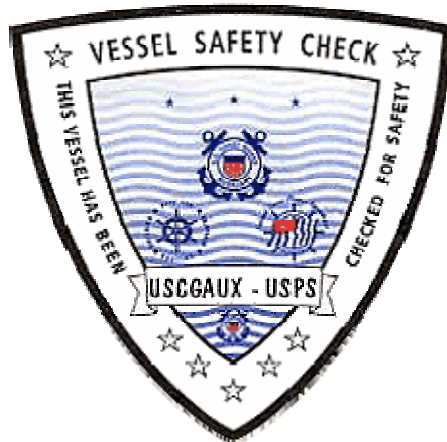


Vessel Safety Check

The Long Island Yacht Club will be organizing a courtesy Vessel Safety Check. The VSC will be conducted by the Great South Bay Power Squadron.



What is a Vessel Safety Check ?

It is a free check of a Vessel's equipment for compliance with Federal, State and Local safety requirements. Some of the Items Checked are:

- Proper display of numbers
- Registration / Documentation
- Personal Flotation Devices
- Visual Distress Signals
- Ventilation
- Backfire Flame Control
- Sound Producing Devices
- Navigation Lights
- State & Local Requirements
- Overall Vessel Condition

This Vessel Check is for the safety of you and other boaters. If your boat does not pass the VSC, there are **No Penalties or Fines given by the USPS.**

The USPS will give you information so you can address safety issues. Passing the VSC will give you peace of mind to know that you have the basic safety equipment and are compliant with Federal, State and Local regulations.

Having the above sticker displayed on your boat could help avoid a potential boarding while underway by Authorities. A random safety Inspection could result in fines or termination of use if a vessel has safety issues in existence.
